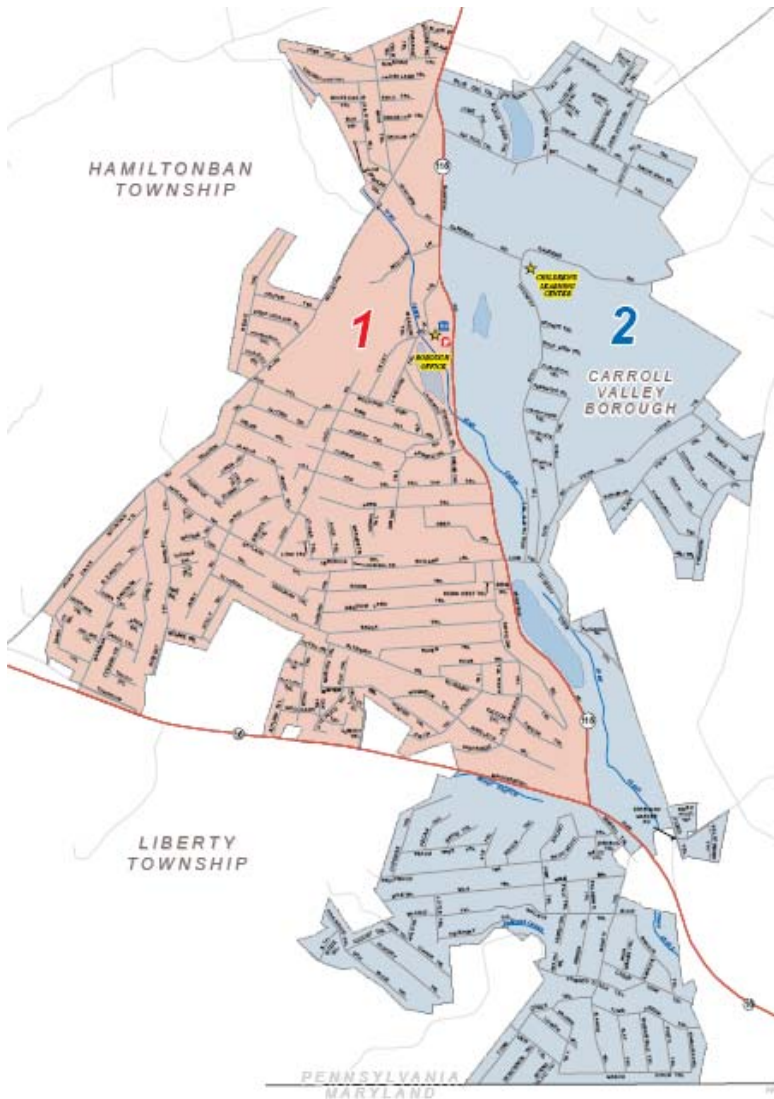

### Election 2009: Primary is May 19

### FOUR!!!! Annual Golf Tournament Coming

The Carroll Valley Citizens' Association (CVCA), partnering with the Carroll Valley July 4<sup>th</sup> Committee, has completed planning for The "CVCA Golf Classic", which is a fund-raising golf tournament to benefit the July 4<sup>th</sup> Celebration Activities at Carroll Commons. 100% of the proceeds will be donated to the July 4<sup>th</sup> Celebration.

The tournament is a four person scramble format and will be held at the Mountain View Golf Course, Fairfield, PA on May 29, 2009. There is a fee of \$55 per golfer, which includes greens and cart fees, donuts, coffee, lunch, soda, beer, and door prizes.

The shotgun start begins at 9 a.m. Prizes will be awarded in three men's flights and one ladies' flight, and for longest drive (male and female), straightest drive (male and female), and closest to pin (male and female). There will also be a \$500 cash prize for any player who scores a hole in one on the 3<sup>rd</sup> hole.

Last year's event was successful in raising over \$2,000 for the Carroll Valley July 4<sup>th</sup> Celebration.

This is a crucial fundraising event for a special day enjoyed by many persons within our community. Without the support of this event, we will be unable to continue to provide the July 4<sup>th</sup> Event and the spectacular Fireworks Show.
