ORDINANCE # 7-2008

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE BOROUGH OF CARROLL VALLEY CODE OF
ORDINANCES UNDER CHAPTER 15, MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Carroll Valley Borough Council to amend its Traffic Regulations Ordinance to establish Through Highways and Stop and Stop intersections, and to add to and delete from said locations from time to time;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Borough of Carroll Valley, Adams County, Pennsylvania, that Chapter 15, Motor Vehicles and Traffic, of the Code of Ordinances of the Borough of Carroll Valley be amended as indicated below.

It is the intention of the Council that the provisions of this Ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Code of Ordinances of the Borough of Carroll Valley and that sections of this Ordinance may be renumbered, as needed, to accomplish such intention.

CHAPTER 15

MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC

Part 2

§15-212. Through Highways Established.

Add the following streets:

<u>Street</u>	<u>Between</u>
Eagles Trail	Thrush Trail and Swallow Trail
Thrush Trail	Skylark Trail and Eagles Trail

§15-213. Stop Intersections Established

Add the following:

<u>Stop Street</u>	<u>Intersection or Through Street</u>	<u>Direction of Travel</u>
Eagles	Thrush	West (Except Right Turn)
Bluebird	Eagles	North

§15-214. Yield Intersections Established

Remove the following:

<u>Yield Street</u>	<u>Intersection or Through Street</u>	<u>Direction of Travel</u>
Eagles	Thrush	West
