### ADMINISTRATIVE BUSINESS – BOROUGH MANAGER

Treasurer's Report for October 2019.

Following brief discussion:

\*\*\* B. Cool moved, B. Carr seconded, that Council accept the October 2019 Treasurer's Report as presented. Motion passed unanimously.

#### 2020 Proposed Budget.

Mr. Mathews expressed concern that the budget included non-merit-based raises for police officers stating that the benefits package is very generous and compensates for the salary being a little lower than the Chief desires for his department. Mr. Verderaime, Mr. Lillard and Ms. Cool also voiced concerns about the salary structure calling for changes before the 2021 budget season. Otherwise, the document was praised for holding the line on taxes with no increase. Two changes were requested to the Budget Message on page iv; in the 3<sup>rd</sup> bullet "Building and Zoning…" remove the duplicate period to end the last sentence. And in the 4<sup>th</sup> bullet "Personnel Costs", end the first sentence with the word "increase" striking the remaining words "equal to what is anticipated for the 2020 SSA COLA". Following discussion:

\*\*\*D. Lillard moved; B. Cool seconded that the 2020 Proposed Budget be advertised as tentatively adopted with the intent to adopt at the December 10, 2019 meeting. Motion passed unanimously.

#### Ordinance #2-2019 and Ordinance #3-2019.

Recently passed changes to the PA Borough Code allows for the Tax Rates to be set by Resolution if there are no changes to the millage rates; therefore, the Ordinances referenced above were discarded and Resolutions will be prepared for action at the December 10, 2019 meeting.

#### F&M Banking Agreement.

Members reviewed the agreement provided by the banking institution acknowledging that all areas of concern were met and following brief discussion:

Verderaime seconded that Council authorize Borough Staff to ratify the Depository Agreement made between Farmers and Merchants Trust Company of Chambersburg, PA d/b/a F&M Trust and the Borough of Carroll Valley effective this date of November 12, 2019. Motion passed unanimously.
