Council acknowledged public comment and engaged in discussion regarding the project whereby questions and concerns were fielded by Sam Wiser, Borough Solicitor and Amy Kauffman, Borough Consultant. Redesign elements included:

- Elimination of one (1) conference room in the Borough office area
- Elimination of one (1) office in the rear of the Borough office area
- Change in size of the manager's office in the Borough office area
- Redesign of the reception/copier-work space/borough secretary office in the Borough office area
- Elimination of one (1) holding cell in the Police Department area
- Reduction and Redesign of the squad room in the Police Department area
- Reduction of the police garage in the Police Department area

These redesign elements reduced the overall footprint of the building by approximately 1200 square feet.
