Members were briefed on the progress of the Adams County Radio Committee's quest for a new county-wide radio system.

National Night Out- Police Secretary and Event Coordinator, Jo Ann Myers, provided a detailed outline of participants for the 2010 event scheduled for Tuesday, August 3, 2010 from 5:00pm until 8:00pm. Chief Hileman provided a brief update regarding the National Night Out's progress. He reported 27 organizations who have confirmed attendance with 4 providing food items. The event is growing each year; members commended his and Jo Ann's work on the project.
