### ORDINANCES and RESOLUTIONS

#### BOROUGH OF CARROLL VALLEY ADAMS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA ORDINANCE #2-2020

AN ORDINANCE OF CARROLL VALLEY BOROUGH, ADAMS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ELECTING TO AMEND ITS POLICE PENSION PLAN ADMINISTERED BY THE PENNSYLVANIA MUNICIPAL RETIREMENT SYSTEM PURSUANT TO ARTICLE IV OF THE PENNSYLVANIA MUNICIPAL RETIREMENT LAW; AGREEING TO BE BOUND BY ALL PROVISIONS OF THE PENNSYLVANIA MUNICIPAL RETIREMENT LAW AS AMENDED AND AS APPLICABLE TO MEMBER MUNICIPALITIES.

IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED, that the Borough Council of The Borough of Carroll Valley, Adams County, amends the Police Pension plan as follows:

SECTION I. Carroll Valley Borough (the Borough), having established a police pension plan administered by the Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement System (the System), hereby elects to amend its Police Pension Plan administered by the System in accordance with Article IV of the Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement Law, 53 P.S. §881.101 et seq. (Retirement Law), and does hereby agree to be bound by all the requirements and provisions of the Retirement Law and the Municipal Pension Plan Funding Standard and Recovery Act, 53 P.S. §895.101 et seq., and to assume all obligations, financial and otherwise, placed upon member municipalities.

SECTION II. As part of this Ordinance, the Borough agrees that the System shall administer and provide the benefits set forth in the amended Police Pension Plan Document entered into between the Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement Board and the Borough effective as of the date specified in the adoption agreement (the Contract).

SECTION III. The Borough acknowledges that by passage and adoption of this Ordinance, the Borough officially accepts the Contract and the financial obligations resulting from the administration of the Contract.

SECTION IV. Payment for any obligation established by the adoption of this Ordinance and the Contract shall be made by the Borough in accordance with the Retirement Law and the Municipal Pension Plan Funding Standard and Recovery Act. The Borough hereby assumes all liability for any unfundedness created due to the benefit structure set forth in the Contract.

SECTION V. The Borough intends this Ordinance to be the complete authorization of the Contract, as amended and it shall become effective as of the date specified in the adoption agreement, which is the effective date of the Contract, as amended.

SECTION VI. A duly certified copy of this Ordinance and an executed Contract shall be filed with the System.

# BOROUGH OF CARROLL VALLEY ADAMS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA ORDINANCE #3-2020

AN ORDINANCE OF CARROLL VALLEY BOROUGH, ADAMS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ELECTING TO AMEND ITS NON-UNIFORM PENSION PLAN ADMINISTERED BY THE PENNSYLVANIA MUNICIPAL RETIREMENT SYSTEM PURSUANT TO ARTICLE IV OF THE PENNSYLVANIA MUNICIPAL RETIREMENT LAW; AGREEING TO BE BOUND BY ALL PROVISIONS OF THE PENNSYLVANIA MUNICIPAL RETIREMENT LAW AS AMENDED AND AS APPLICABLE TO MEMBER MUNICIPALITIES.

IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED, that the Borough Council of The Borough of Carroll Valley, Adams County, amends the Non-Uniform Pension plan as follows:

SECTION I. Carroll Valley Borough (the Borough), having established a non-uniform pension plan administered by the Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement System (the System), hereby elects to amend its Non-Uniform Pension Plan administered by the System in accordance with Article IV of the Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement Law, 53 P.S. §881.101 et seq. (Retirement Law), and does hereby agree to be bound by all the requirements and provisions of the Retirement Law and the Municipal Pension Plan Funding Standard and Recovery Act, 53 P.S. §895.101 et seq., and to assume all obligations, financial and otherwise, placed upon member municipalities.

SECTION II. As part of this Ordinance, the Borough agrees that the System shall administer and provide the benefits set forth in the amended Non-Uniform Pension Plan Document entered into between the Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement Board and the Borough effective as of the date specified in the adoption agreement (the Contract).

SECTION III. The Borough acknowledges that by passage and adoption of this Ordinance, the Borough officially accepts the Contract and the financial obligations resulting from the administration of the Contract.

SECTION IV. ### September 2020 Police Report

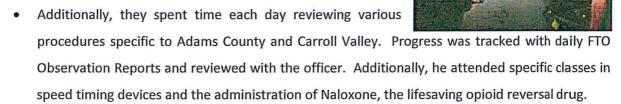

NOTE: Based on feedback from the Borough Council Ad Hoc group, it is our pleasure to present this new report format for your consideration. Please note historical data has not been added, pending feedback on the format.

#### **Special News / Achievements:**

- During the month, new Patrol Officer Eric Peiffer participated in our field training program in order
- to test his academy training, acclimate him to the Department and train him in our methods and procedures. Corporal Clifford J. Weikert acted as his field training officer (FTO), observing his performance, teaching, and counselling him on applying academy training to real world situations.



### **Monthly Activities:**

- There is a clear spike continuing in September in theft and damage to election signs. One subject
  was charged with theft and displaying fake registration plates in September for an August theft
  where the suspect was caught as he attempted to flee the scene.
- We recovered wooden carvings stolen from the Jason Stoner at Zora valued in excess of \$800. The investigation remains open.
- We investigated and cleared as unfounded (investigation determined that it was not a crime) a reported burglary to a residence.
- A repeated harassment of a resident was resolved by the identification of the juveniles involved and handled informally with the parents.



 11 calls occurred outside coverage hours, including a DUI Crash, domestic disturbance, two reports of shots fired and a report of suspicious activity.

#### **Traffic Enforcement:**

- Officers conducted 27 vehicle stops resulting in 35 citations, faulty equipment notices and warnings, 18 of which were for maximum speed limits.
- Four vehicle crashes were investigated including when officers captured an intoxicated operator
  who crashed in a resident's yard and was trying to flee with a BAC of .0207, more than 2 and ½
  times the legal limit.
- One additional DUI arrest was made.

#### **Upcoming Events:**

- October 24<sup>th</sup> from 10 AM to 2 PM, Police will conduct a drive through drug take back in front of the Borough office as part of the US Drug Enforcement Administration's National Prescription Drug Take Back Day. All drugs collected with be delivered to US DEA for destruction.
- In October, CPL Weikert will attend a Field Training Officer
   Certification Program from Penn State's Justice and Safety
   Institute.





 Additionally, he will attend a Controlled F.O.R.C.E. instructor certification class with the goal of developing training curriculums and standardizations in low-liability methods of subject control.

#### DCNR COMMUNITY CONSERVATION PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM (C2P2) UPDATE

Carroll Valley Path System - Phase I

Awarded \$84,564

On May 28, 2020, the Borough received formal notification from DCNR that it has six months to secure the easements for the Project (end of November 2020 deadline). *Eluma has confirmed it is no longer willing to provide easement for the Trail. Due to federal funding requirements, realigning the trail with use of the grant is not a viable option.* The original scope of work and trail alignment went through a federal environment review process and was approved. A change in alignment will trigger another federal environmental review process. DCNR has advised that this process will take far longer than the time remaining in our November 2020 deadline. At this time, the only remaining option is to relinquish the grant award and re-apply for funding in a future round once the trail realignment is decided and easements are in place. DCNR is aware of the intent to re-apply has endorsed this plan.

Next Steps: GMS will draft an official relinquishment of grant award notice for the Borough to review, sign, and submit to DCNR. Utilize County grant funds to design realignment. Re-apply for C2P2 in a subsequent round when easements are in place.

#### H2O PA - WATER SUPPLY, SANITARY SEWER AND STORM WATER PROJECTS (H2O)

Wastewater Treatment Plant Upgrades

Awarded: \$700,000

The executed grant agreement for \$700,000 has been received. H2O PA requires a 50/50 grant/match ratio. The Authority should begin the design process for the Project.

Next Steps: The Borough should forward all engineer invoices and payments to GMS. Once the Project is designed, the Authority should move forward with the bidding process. The Authority should provide GMS all draft bid documents for compliance review prior to public advertisement and solicitation of bids.
