Special News / Achievements:

- Patrol Officer Peiffer assisted at a diabetic emergency and was able to assist the victim and stabilize their blood sugar while waiting on EMS.
- Patrol Officer Groft was stopped by a citizen and thanked for his efforts in speed reduction on Jacks Mountain Road.



- The Carroll Valley Borough Police Department has partnered with the Rite Aid Foundation and KidCents Safe Medication Disposal Program to offer a medication disposal unit at the police station. The KidCents program focuses on reducing drug accessibility, medication misuse and accidental poisoning among children and teens. The box is available any time the Borough Office is open.



Monthly Activities:

- A year-long harassment by communications investigation finally yielded an arrest.
- A missing juvenile was tracked and returned safely home within hours.



- Police are conducting a death investigation in probable drug overdose.
- Police destroyed a raccoon found to be sick or possibly rabid.
- Two child abuse investigations continued resulting in forensic interviews in the Adams County Child Advocacy Center.
- 9 calls occurred outside coverage hours, including a death investigation, welfare check, missing juvenile, and 2 crashes.

Traffic Enforcement:

- Officers conducted 38 vehicle stops resulting in 38 citations, faulty equipment notices, and warnings, 21 of which were for stop signs.
- 4 vehicle crashes, including one with injuries.



Upcoming Events:



- The Department intends on helping Santa safely tour the community on a fire engine from our local fire companies. It is rumored that dear, old St. Nick will be launching candy to all the boys and girls not on the naughty list as he drives through the neighborhoods. Santa's route is still top secret and has only been shared to date with
